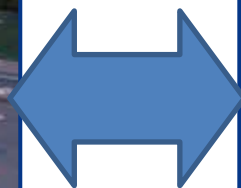
What is Project Journey?

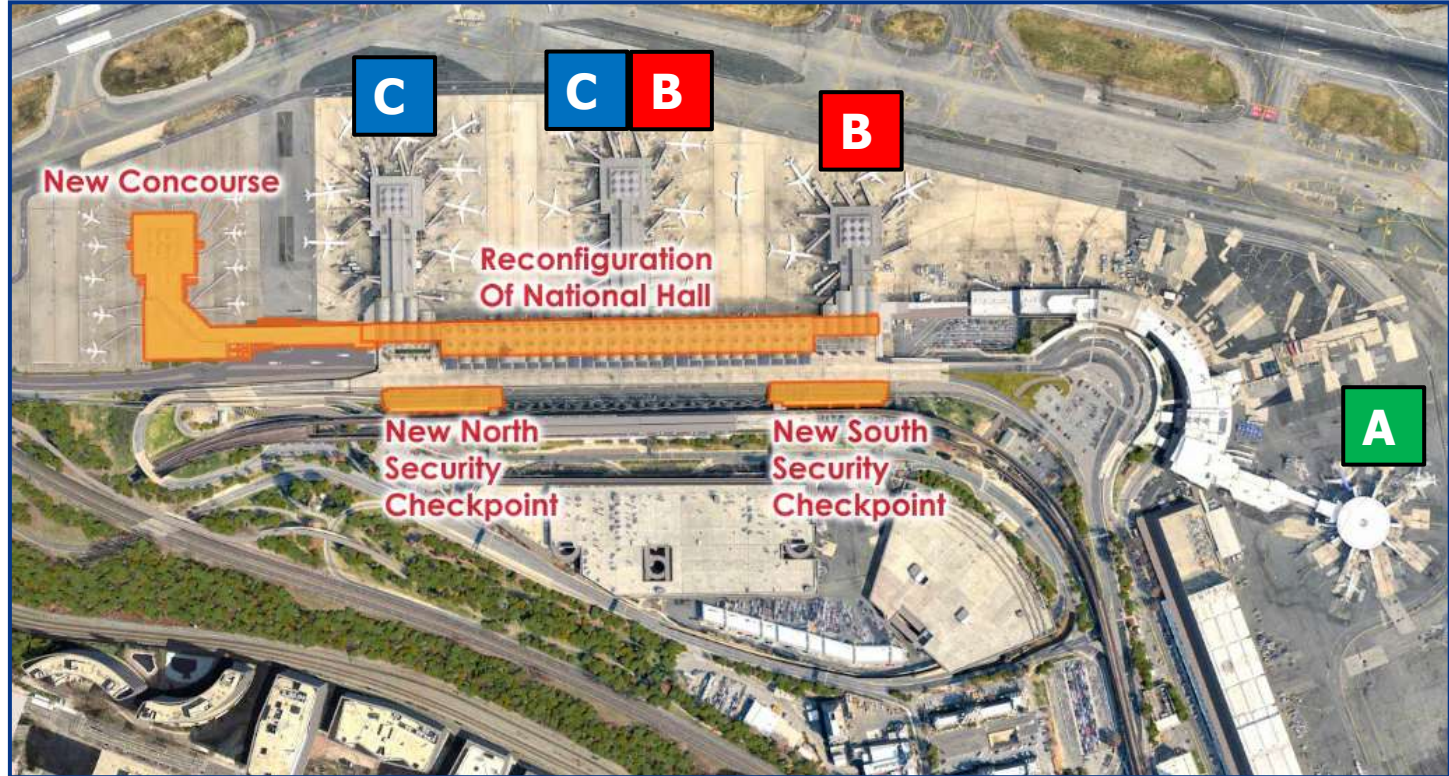

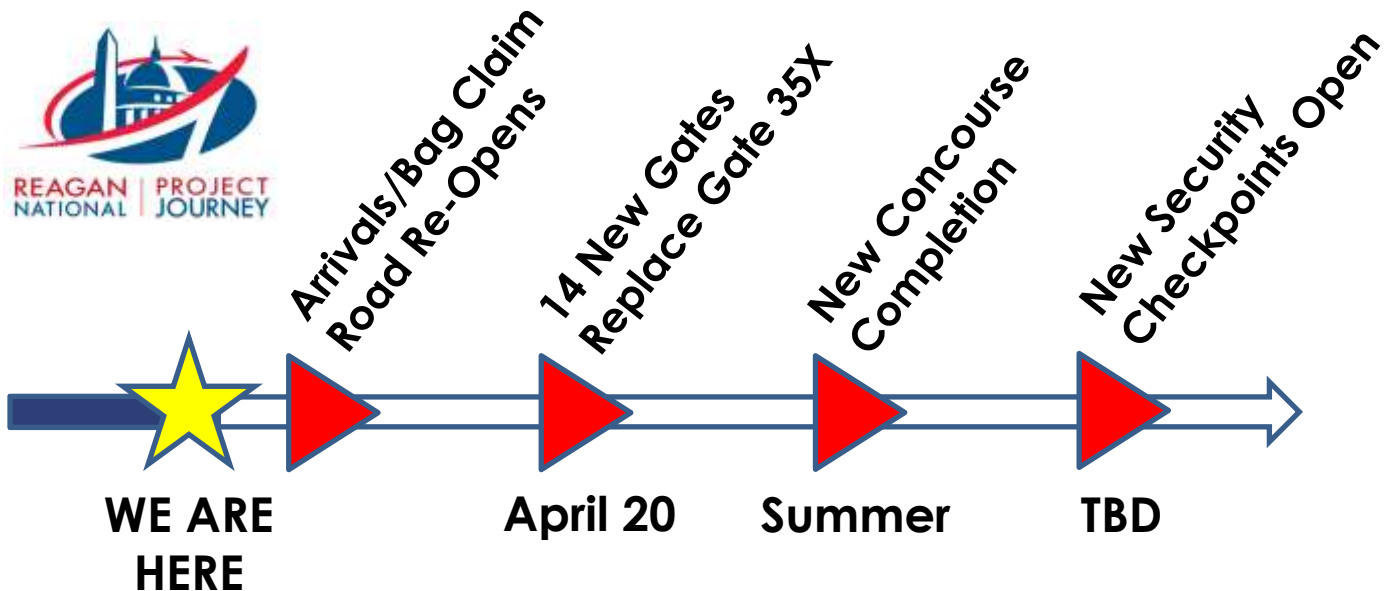

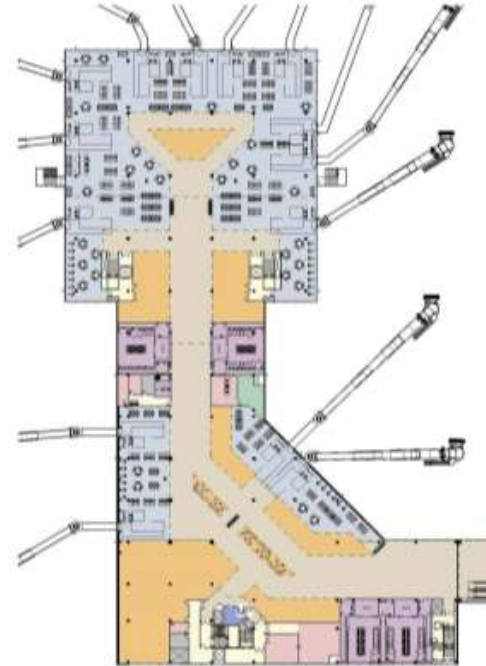

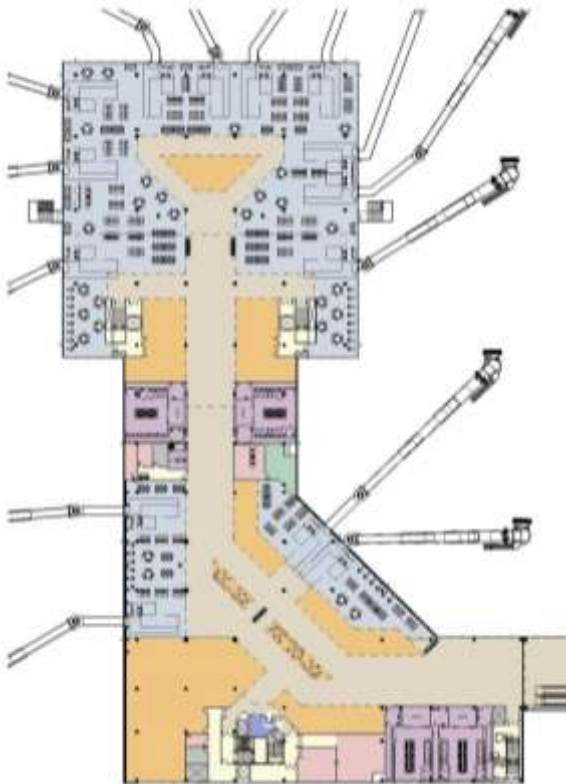

- Re-grade land for optimal drainage ✓
- Assemble structural steel ✓
- Pave aircraft parking ✓
- Install curtain wall ✓
- Activate utility service ✓
- Fit-out interior and jet bridges (in progress)
- ***Opening April 20, 2021***

Two New Security Screening Checkpoints

Current Screening Configuration



- Checkpoints designed pre-9/11/01
- Screening lanes maxed out
- Queues spill into National Hall
- Clogs passenger movement
- Inconvenient transfer between piers
- Passengers skip pre-security food options, crowding the piers

Solution: Remove/Relocate Checkpoints

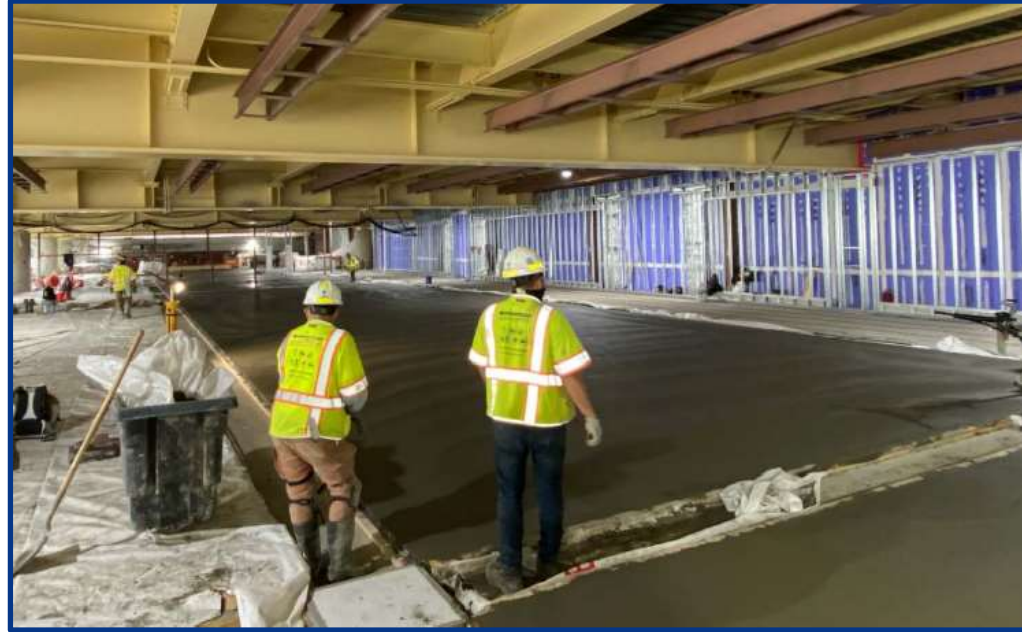

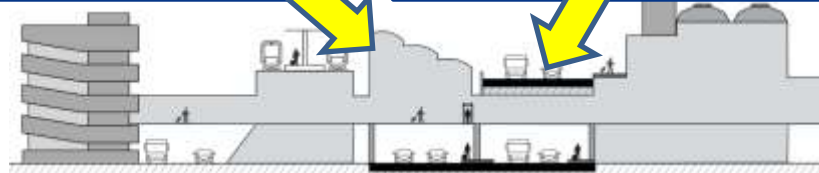

Security Checkpoints – Milestones

- Install piles and support columns ✓
- Erect structural steel above arrivals roadway ✓
- Build out exterior with panes of glass ✓
- Reopen roadway lanes beneath structure (soon)
- Fit-out interior
- ***Opening later this year (2021)***

PROJECT JOURNEY UPDATE

March 2021

Signs of Change: Overhead signs in Terminal B/C have been updated to include 14 new gates that will open soon at Reagan National.

Major construction of new passenger facilities at Reagan National Airport is entering the home stretch. Key milestones that are designed to bring the main elements of Project Journey to a successful conclusion are on the menu for delivery in 2021.

Hard-working crews will spend the next several weeks preparing the new 14-gate concourse for a soft opening that will transition American Airlines regional jet operations to newly minted jetbridge gates. The concourse's debut will signal the end of busking at Gate 35X for good, with the activation of new gates 46 through 59.
