





- American Airlines Admirals Club (upstairs)









New 14-Gate Concourse – Milestones



- Re-grade land for optimal drainage ✓
- Assemble structural steel ✓
- Pave aircraft parking ✓
- Install curtain wall ✓
- Activate utility service ✓
- Fit-out interior and jet bridges (in progress)
- Opening April 20, 2021



Two New Security Screening Checkpoints



Current Screening Configuration



- Checkpoints designed pre-9/11/01
- Screening lanes maxed out
- Queues spill into National Hall
- Clogs passenger movement
- Inconvenient transfer between piers
- Passengers skip pre-security food options, crowding the piers



Solution: Remove/Relocate Checkpoints










National Hall – To Be Divided








National Hall – Mesh and Glass

Security Checkpoints – Milestones

- Install piles and support columns ✓
- Erect structural steel above arrivals roadway ✓
- Build out exterior with panes of glass ✓
- Reopen roadway lanes beneath structure (soon)
- Fit-out interior
- Opening later this year (2021)


