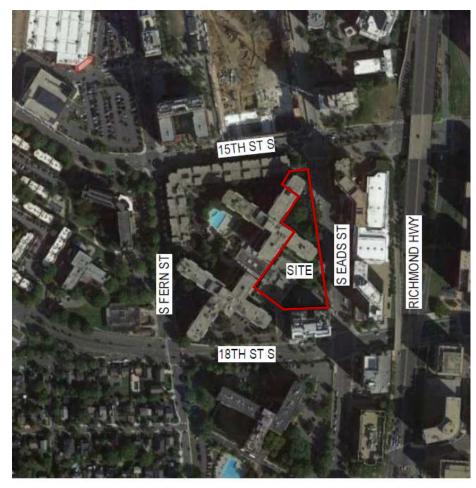

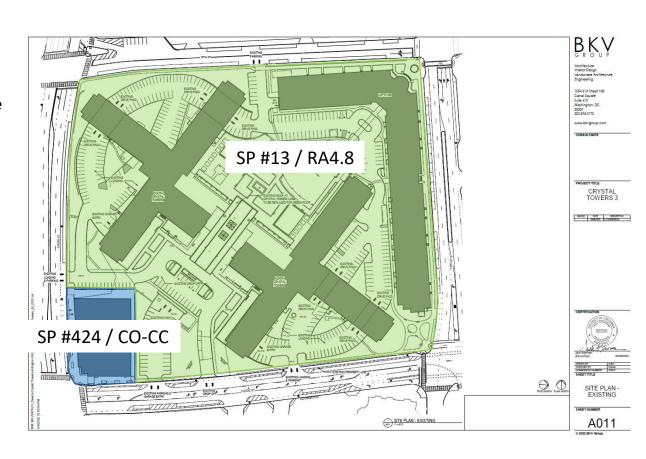
Property Overview

- Dweck owns & operates 1,110 existing units on the block
 - > Crystal Towers 912 Units
 - > Crystal Flats 198 Units
- > Crystal Towers Property 451,297 SF (9.7 Acres) Land Area
- > 1,132 Existing Parking Spaces 205 Spaces Currently Under-utilized at Towers 106 Spaces Currently Under-utilized at Flats



Existing Property Zoning

- Currently Zoned RA4.8 & indicated on the GLUP as High-Medium which is consistent with existing zoning
- Property falls withing the Crystal City Sector Plan Boundary
- Proposing the new buildings under an amendment to SP #13 without a rezoning to CO-Crystal City
- RA4.8 allows for 3.24 FAR (including ground floor commercial) and 136' in height (including mechanical penthouses and parapets)

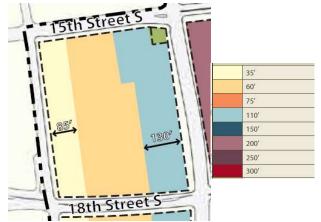

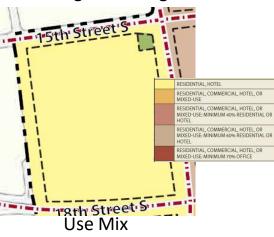

BKV Design Concept

- > Proposed infill development of two existing surface parking lots off Eads St.
- > 11 Story, Mixed-Use Building
 - > 133' in height
- > 209 Multifamily Units
 - > 0.3 spaces per unit
 - > 127 bike parking spaces (0.6 spaces / unit)
- > 800 Average SF Unit Size
- > 27K SF of Ground Floor Retail
- > LEED Gold
 - > Intending to participate in the new Arlington County Green Building Incentive Program

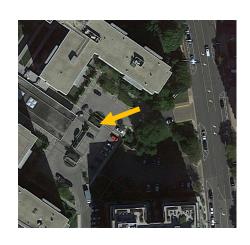

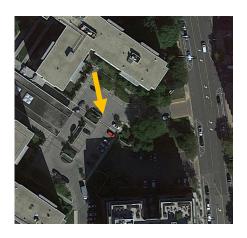

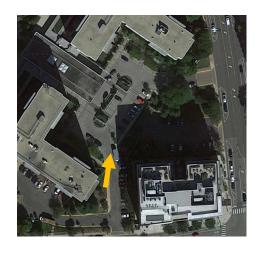

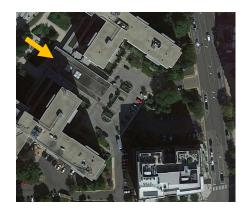

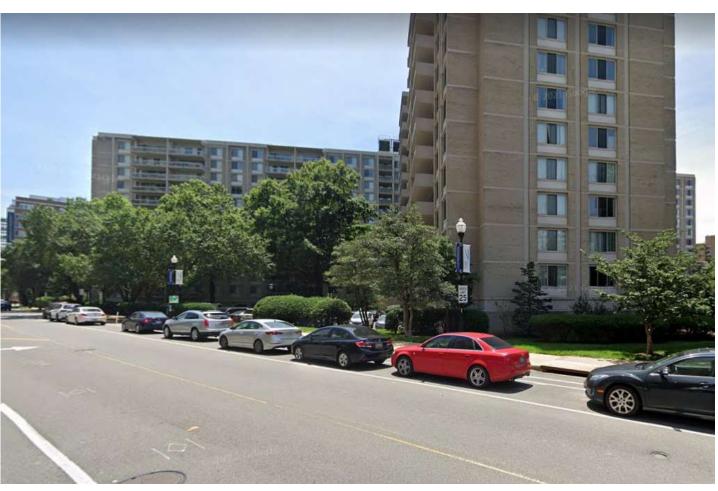

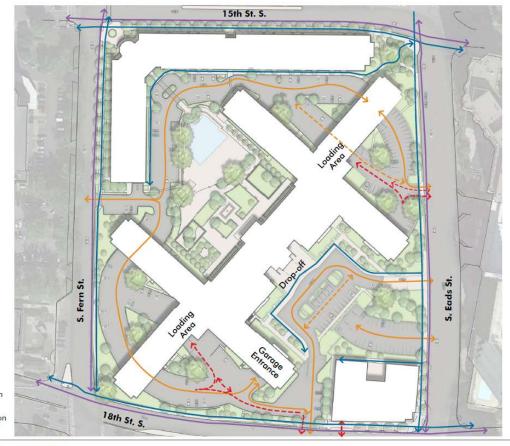


Site Landscape & Streetscape Improvements

- > Flexible program area (i.e. food trucks)
- > Green wall
- Artificial turf lawn



Existing Parking/Loading Circulation

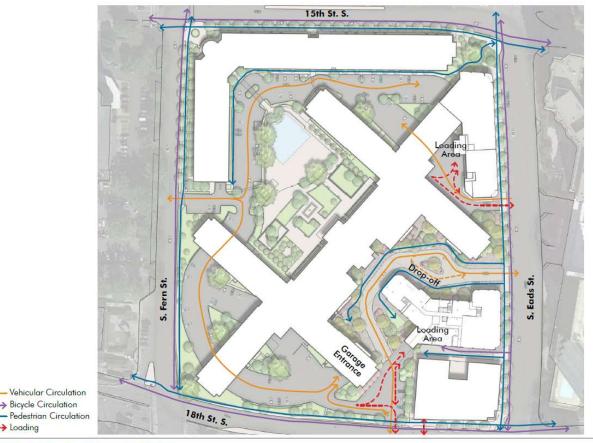


Vehicular Circulation → Bicycle Circulation - Pedestrian Circulation Loading
