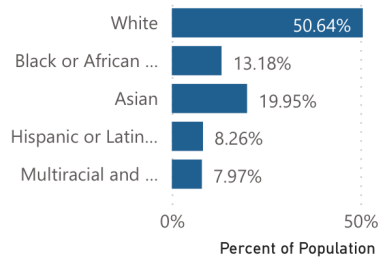

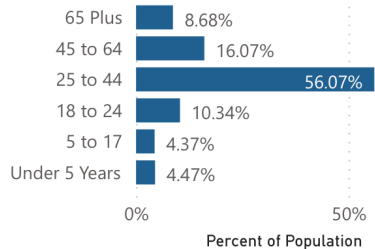

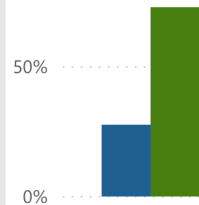

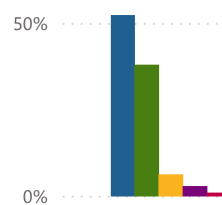

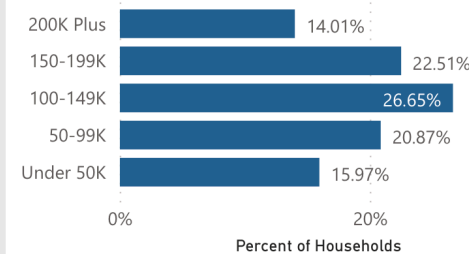

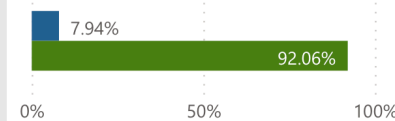

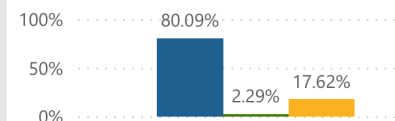
#### Housing Unit Occupancy

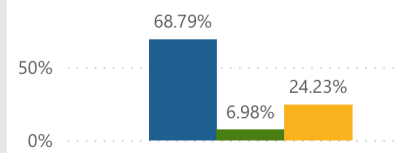
#### Housing Costs as Percent of Income Owner Occupied Units

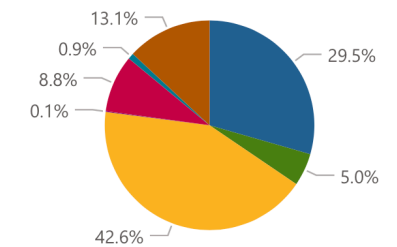

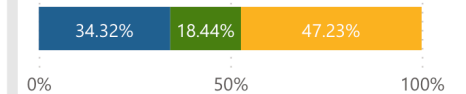
#### Means of Transportation to Work
